Range Safety Rules

- 1. Always point the muzzle in a safe direction. When on the range, always point your firearm down range.**
- 2. Keep the action open and the gun unloaded until you are on the firing line and ready to fire.**
- 3. Loading and unloading of firearms will only be done on the firing line.**
- 4. Keep your finger straight and off the trigger until you are ready to fire.**
- 5. Know how the firearm operates. Before handling any firearm, know the basic parts, how to load and unload ammunition safely and how the safety devices work.**
- 6. Be sure your gun and ammunition are compatible.**
- 7. Do not set targets on top of the wood frames. Staple or tape targets to the frames only! Do not use nails as they can be lost & found in the lawn mower tires. Do not shoot broadhead arrows in the new foam targets – broadheads are to be shot in the sand pile only.**
- 8. Wear appropriate eye and ear protection.**
- 9. Do NOT mix alcohol and/or drugs with shooting.**
- 10. No shooting permitted when farmer is working in adjacent field.**
- 11. No shooting permitted during any club rentals.**
- 12. All rifle/handgun shooting will be done in a southerly direction into the dirt mounds.**
- 13. No shooting after hours; Sundays and Holidays – 10AM to 6PM, other days – 8AM to 8PM.**
- 14. No glass objects/containers are permitted as targets.**
- 15. No one under the age of 18 is allowed to shoot unless under the direct supervision of an adult member.**
